Background

The Education Review Office reviews schools that are signatories to the *Education (Pastoral Care of Tertiary and International Learners) Code of Practice 2021* established under section 534 of the Education and Training Act 2020.

Findings

The school is a signatory to the Education (Pastoral Care of Tertiary and International Learners) Code of Practice 2021 established under section 534 of the Education and Training Act 2020. The school has attested that it complies with all aspects of the Code and has completed an annual self review of its implementation of the Code.

At the time of this review there were 20 international students attending the school.

The school has established processes for reviewing its provision for international students and compliance with the Code. School governance and leadership are informed about student wellbeing, learning and engagement. The school has developed appropriate documentation to inform international students about the school.

The school seeks regular feedback from students about their school and homestay experiences. Care is taken over course selection to match international students' interests and to support their plans beyond school. The school has well established processes for maintaining contact with host families as well as international students' parents and caregivers.

Students report that they appreciate their meetings with the director who monitors their academic progress and wellbeing. They are involved in a wide range of school extra curricula activities, as well as in activities outside school.
